

CAMPUS CHILDREN'S DIRECTOR

Job Title: Campus Children's Director

Ministry Purpose: Consistent with Romans 12:9-15 and Ephesians 4:11-12, all Bethlehem Church Employees are responsible for assisting the Pastor and staff in carrying out the daily ministry functions of Bethlehem Church and all other duties as assigned.

Job Description: To provide leadership and organization for Children's Ministry volunteers and Bethlehem Church families for a specified campus.

Job Classification: Full-time

Responsibilities:

- Recruit, train, and coordinate volunteers for campus Children's Ministry classes (during worship services) and events (small groups, trainings, Discover Bethlehem, etc.)
- Responsible for the on-boarding process of volunteers (background checks, volunteer handbook, hands-on training) and provide leadership in their ongoing development
- Oversee and coordinate all aspects of the Sunday experience for Children's Ministry (check-in, safety, and overall appearance)
- Work cooperatively with Campus Pastor, all staff, and volunteers
- Implement and maintain clear and consistent communication with campus leadership,
 Children's Ministry team and volunteers
- Provide a safe, friendly, and learning environment for children and families
- Communicate the needs of Children's Ministry to the Central Children's Ministry Leadership Team
- Organize, set up, and stock classrooms with necessary supplies
- Oversee and implement monthly decor changes as needed
- Coordinate sanitation procedures and ensure that all safety protocols for CM are followed
- Visit classes for evaluation and volunteer support to address any issues or emergencies that may arise
- Oversee budget for campus Children's Ministry
- Attend weekly staff and Children's Ministry meetings
- Oversee and coordinate Children's Ministry discipleship process (KidFaith, Child Dedication, etc.)
- Participate in yearly evaluations
- Other tasks as assigned

- Maintain a Godly attitude and follow the guidelines outlined in the Bethlehem Church Employee Handbook for how to biblically handle conflict
- Ability to maintain confidentiality
- Highly organized
